

NDA Kroger & Remke Cards

Use these cards whenever you shop at Kroger and Remkes and
NDA will automatically receive cash rewards!

How to use your NDA Kroger & Remke Cards

1. You put money onto the card – this is called ‘re-loading’ the card.

- Use cash, check or a credit card to ‘re-load’ the card.
- The value can be added at any register or at the service desk.
- If you re-load at the register, you need to do so before any scanning starts.
- ***Just remember - the re-loading of the card must be a separate transaction.***

2. Then use the card to pay.

- Any money left on the card can be used for future purchases.

It is that easy!

- A NDA Kroger and NDA Remke card were sent home with your daughter.
- These cards are linked to NDA; all you have to do is load them and use them!
- The Kroger Card has a \$1 on it - cost paid by the school.
- The Remke Card has no value on it – was provided at no cost to the school.
- **Krogers and Remkes takes care of adding up *all* the ‘re-loads’ on *all* the NDA cards and issues a rebate check for 4% of the total every 4 weeks.**

Do you already have a NDA Kroger or Remke Card?

- Then give this card to your spouse, a grandparent or other family member, neighbor, friend, or co-worker and they too can support NDA!
- Load this card for your college student heading off to school. (You can even re-load it for them from home! See back for details.)
- If you have a gift card for another organization – consider alternating use with this one – as every re-load helps!

Frequently Asked Questions

About the Kroger Neighborhood Reward Program

How do I know the balance on my card?

You can check your card balance at the store or you can go to www.gcbalance.com and enter your card number. The balance is also printed on a receipt when you load and when you use the card. Or you can call 1-866-822-6252.

Do I still need to use my Kroger Plus Card?

Yes, you still need to give the cashier your Kroger Plus Card to get the specials and sale prices.

Can I use the card at the pharmacy?

Yes, the card can be used for any merchandise in a Kroger store, including area fuel centers. The only exclusion is services, which includes money orders, Western Union, Lottery Tickets, Stamps and Ticket Master.

Is there a limit to the amount that can be loaded onto the card?

Yes, \$250 is the maximum amount that can be loaded at one time by check or \$500 by cash or credit card.

Do I have to get my card from NDA?

Yes, the cards are electronically coded for NDA and must be obtained through the school.

Can I get an additional card?

Yes, if you would like to get a card for someone else or need to replace your card, contact Sr. Paul Ann at school.

How long is the card good for?

You can continue to use the same card as long as it works. The only time a card is deactivated is if it has a zero balance for 90 days. Cards that have a zero balance for 90 days are deleted from the system.

Can you use the card at Kroger stores outside this area?

Yes, the card is good at any Kroger in the US, as well as Kroger affiliate companies that are listed on the card itself.

How do I load my college student's card who is living away from home?

Write down the number found on the back of their NDA gift card. Then take that gift card number to the service desk at a Kroger store and load the card.

What if my card doesn't work?

Occasionally the magnetic strip is 'demagnetized'. If this happens the balance on the card can be transferred to a new card. Contact Sr. Paul Ann at school to get new card. Then take both the old card and the new card to Kroger's for them to transfer the balance.

What if my purchase total is more than there is on my gift card?

Additional money may be added to the card at another register or at the Service Desk before paying.
