




Then onto Carmel Mission where we watched the sunset next to the 18th hole at Pebble Beach.

NDA's Co-Ed Junior High Art Camp 2016

This summer we will be focusing on a process done by legendary street artist Vhils. Students will be creating a piece of artwork by digitally manipulating an image, recreating that image on a piece of stencil paper, carving out a portion of that image and creating a background to show through the cut out areas. <u>https://sites.google.com/site/ndajuniorhighsummerstudioart/</u>

Who: Any current 6th, 7th, and 8th Grader

What: Students will:

- learn a basic intro to Photoshop
- be introduced to street artist Vhils and his work
- learn how to create a piece using layers that involves building layers
- NEED an image on a flash drive that they would want to use. (face, object, place)
- When: Session A: July 11th July 14th, 6pm 8pm (Limit 20 students) Session B: July 25th – July 28th, 6pm – 8pm (Limit 20 students)

Where: The Art Studio at Notre Dame Academy

Cost: \$75 per student (with this particular project, students will be using paper and found images to create their piece. They will also be using an exacto-knife and will be taught how to use this tool. If the tool is used IN ANY WAY that seems dangerous, the student may be asked not to return for the remainder of the class.)
