ACT Prep Course June 4 - 8, 2018 | 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Cost: \$300

This summer, Notre Dame Academy is kicking off its **Panda Test Prep Program** with an ACT Prep Course. The course will be held Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. each day. This ACT Prep Course is aligned with the June 9 and July 14 ACT test dates. The course will be taught by NDA faculty members and features:

- Five 3-hour classes Monday, June 4 Friday, June 8 | 9:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m.
- Small Class Size Class will be limited to 20 students
- Personalized Learning Curriculum will be tailored to the needs of students based on past standardized test scores (CERT and ACT) taken by participating students
