

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Greetings Parents,

The juniors took an ACT practice test this morning as part of a program sponsored by Torchprep –the ACT Boot Camp providers. Torchprep will meet with the juniors next Wednesday at 8:00 a.m. to review the test and strategies for taking standardized tests. They will hold an informational meeting for parents on September 18 at 7:00 p.m. Please note the parent meeting will be held at Covington Catholic.

Parent Mini Night is just around the corner on September 10 from 7-9 p.m. This is a special evening when you can visit each of your daughter's classes for a 10-minute overview about course expectations and activities. Your daughter will bring home her Wednesday schedule for you to follow that night. This is not a time for individual parent- teacher conferences as the teachers will be addressing parents as a group. Handbook Reminders

Early Release

Notes from parents requesting that students be permitted to leave school early should be brought to the school office before school, so an Office Permission Slip can be issued. It is important that the student take care of this when she arrives at school for attendance purposes. If a student becomes ill during the school day, she must contact a parent/guardian from the school office. She is not permitted to contact a parent via email, cell phone or iPad.

Excused Absences

Excused absences are absences NOT counted toward a student's missed days; however, they will still be reflected on the student's attendance record. These would include:

- 1) College Days A "college day" is a day on which a senior or junior is scheduled to visit a college or university. College days are not mandatory. The student must obtain a <u>verification form</u> from the school office to take with her. This is to be returned to NDA signed by a college official. Failure to provide verification will result in an unexcused absence. College visits are not excused after April 30 of the academic year. Between their junior and senior year, students are allotted 5 total excused college visit days.
- 2) Funerals of immediate relatives, or others in consultation with the Assistant Principal.
- 3) Participation in an NDA sponsored activity in which a student will miss class time.
- 4) Attendance at NDA/CCH athletic events that occur during school hours at the discretion of the administration through public notification.

A request for an Excused Absence Form can be made through the school office or a copy can be downloaded from the website. The form is to be completed for any student who has a documented chronic condition, is having surgery, or must miss school repeatedly for reasons beyond her control. Forms should be completed within two weeks of a student's return to school after a prolonged absence. Documented absences supported by this form may be excused upon review by the Assistant Principal.




