#### **GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT**

The **Governor's School for the Arts Program** for high school sophomores and juniors is currently allowing application submittal online. The GSA Program recently allowed students to start submitting his or her applications and sign up for ArtShops (practice and informational sessions) for participants through the website, <a href="www.kentuckygsa.org">www.kentuckygsa.org</a>. Mrs. Monohan offered informational sessions after school in regards to the GSA Program. Please see Mrs. Monohan with any questions.

There is a program offered through the **Greater Cincinnati Health Foundation called Tap MD** that is currently seeking high school juniors. The program allows talented Tristate students to explore medicine each month in 2012. They will visit Tristate hospitals, outpatient clinics, and community sites as they shadow medical physicians. Applicants will be screened by the UC School of Medicine to determine their chance of future success. Students need to be at least 16 years of age and a junior in high school. The participants also need to have a high ACT/SAT (29/1300) score. The **sophomores and juniors** took the practice SAT (PSAT) on Wednesday of this week. Results will be reviewed with parents at the January 11 meeting for juniors and the January 18 meeting for sophomores. We will also discuss the PLAN test for sophomores as well scheduling and college planning at these meetings.
