#### LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Greetings Parents,

As we all prepare to enjoy our Spring Break, may each of our students be safe and healthy during this time. I hope they will be spending their days relaxing and enjoying their break (perhaps even reading a good book). I trust our students will make good choices, respecting the beautiful minds and bodies that God has given each of them.

In the last couple of months we have addressed the girls about the importance of respecting and protecting themselves in the choices they make. This past month, our speaker addressed the legal implications of turning 18 and reminded our students of the potentially life changing consequences of illegal alcohol and drug use. Students and parents should be aware of and discuss the laws that govern the illegal use of drugs and alcohol. On March 2, our students heard about the reality of human trafficking even in our own country. They learned of the ways in which some people would take advantage of them and engage them in activities that threaten their health and safety in very serious sometimes life-threatening ways. Young people are more vulnerable to these threats when they are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Last week our speaker from the Women's Crisis Center spoke to the girls about the importance of watching out for each other and intervening when a friend is tempted to use alcohol or drugs and therefore put themselves in a dangerous or threatening situation. (Ask them about the Green Dot program.) This past week we talked to our juniors and seniors about how they present themselves by the way they dress and communicate through online behaviors including pictures and comments on Facebook and Twitter. Please talk to your daughters and make sure they are aware of the importance, even life saving consequences, of making good choices and respecting the person God has meant them to be. It is never a bad idea to have this conversation with young people.

Today we celebrated our Holy Week Prayer Service as a school community. This celebration focused on the importance of service to others and the many ways in which our school has provided service this school year. The list is quite impressive and we have a very generous and giving community. This was recently made clear in comments offered by representatives of some of our partner agencies. They expressed deep appreciation for the commitment, graciousness and respect shown by our girls in their service to our community.

Finally, may you and each member of your family enjoy a very blessed Easter weekend. May the promise of the Resurrection give you a sense of hope and peace.
