LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Greetings Parents,

This week I have some very exciting news to share with you. Notre Dame Academy is launching our **One to One Initiative: Embracing 21st Century Learners** for the 2012-13 school year. Starting this August, students will use iPads in their NDA classes.

We see all around us the daily use of mobile devices giving quick and easy access to vast amounts of information as well as the ability for 24/7 communication. The majority of young people have access to these mobile devices in every part of their lives except when they are at school. As this technology has become central to our culture it is incumbent upon educators to consider the responsibilities and opportunities we have to teach our students about the effective use of this technology. It is our belief that we must educate our young women to become responsible digital citizens - to be able to access and process the vast amounts of information available to them in responsible, ethical and effective ways. This coincides with an overwhelming opportunity to use technology to support best instructional practices. It is our belief that this will lead to more effective student engagement and greater learning.

Effective with this coming school year, all students will be required to have an iPad as part of their school supplies. After considering the number of individuals who already own these devices or desire to do so, we thought it would be best to implement this as a "bring your own iPad" (BYOI) initiative. Look for information about this program, its requirements and use in the classroom on our web page soon. Please note that this will be a live page that will be updated continuously as more information becomes available, check it often.

This is a challenging initiative and major change for our school, teachers, students and families. We ask for your patience as we continue to work out the many details of the program. Over the summer we will have orientation sessions available to our students. We will also provide information to our parents at the August parent meetings. These dates will be announced on our web page soon.

I appreciate your support as we all work together to implement the iPad Initiative for NDA and promote ongoing improvements in student learning.
