COUNSELING AND STUDENT SERVICES

Juniors and Junior Parents:

This is a reminder that we will be having the March District Choice ACT test for all NDA juniors on March 15. We will register the students for the test during the school day (long homeroom periods) in the coming weeks, so there is not a need to go online and register for this test. The cost of the test is \$39.50 (no writing test) and the



students can bring a check (made out to NDA) to the school office for this amount by March 11. Financial assistance is available for those who may need it. This is a real ACT test and the scores can be sent to colleges.

Also, TorchPrep is hosting a session to prep for this test at NDA (for NDA and Cov Cath students) starting February 11 and lasting until March 12 (9 week prep class on Thursdays from 6 p.m. - 9 p.m. & Saturdays 10 a.m. - 2 p.m.). Seniors: FAFSA Now Available

Attention Senior Parents: As of January 1, seniors are now able to fill out the 2016-2017 FAFSA (College Financial Aid Application).

It is highly recommended that families complete the FAFSA in the first 2-3 weeks of January. If a family qualifies for Grant money (especially Grants from Kentucky), they are first come, first serve. Most colleges ask that you complete the FAFSA by Feb. 1 or Feb. 15.


