Blessings friends,

On Monday we held an all-school assembly to touch base with our students about the purpose and goals of PANDA PRIME TIME. We reiterated how PANDA PRIME TIME offers students many opportunities for enrichment, support, collaboration and personal learning. We stressed how this added period has been a prime time for students to learn how to balance and organize time, leading them to success in college and beyond. I truly believe that this new 30-minute period which occurs twice each week, has changed school at Notre Dame Academy.

As I told our students, it is imperative that we committed to being lifelong learners at NDA. Here are a few ways that PANDA PRIME TIME helps to make that possible:

- Feedback: PANDA PRIME TIME allows students to get important feedback from their teachers.
- Formative vs. Summative: In addition to traditional summative assessments, PANDA PRIME TIME enables formative assessments which forms learning and lesson plans at NDA.
- **Reflection:** It is important for students to contemplate not only what they are learning but how they are learning. Reflective learners are the most successful learners.
- Relationships: Student/teacher relationships are critical to learning. PANDA PRIME TIME allows students to meet with faculty on a regular basis, building strong relationships.
- **Growth Mindset:** When students believe they can get smarter, they understand that effort makes them stronger. A growth mindset encourages appropriate healthy risk-taking, knowing that some risks won't work out.
- **Asking for help:** PANDA PRIME TIME encourages students to ask for help which becomes a source of strength for them. They become more comfortable reaching out to teachers which will benefit them greatly in college.

I encourage you to talk to your daughter about Monday's presentation regarding PANDA PRIME TIME. I truly believe that it is providing time for students to address academic, emotional, physical and spiritual needs through a multitude of opportunities.
