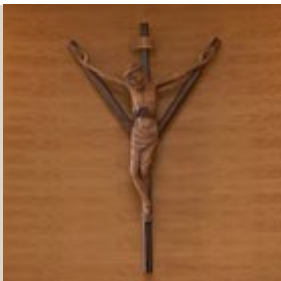
T-Shirt Bags
