## HANDBOOK HIGHLIGHT ◀

As we embrace remote learning from our new classrooms, students are reminded of NDA's expectations as they apply to the online educational tools supplied by the school. As found in the Student/Parent Handbook (p. 29), the following are reminders for students as they engage with their teachers and peers online:

- The acceptable modes of electronic communication include the school email and Unified Classroom Learning Management System. Other communication apps must be approved by school personnel.
- The use of the email account must be used in support of education and research, consistent with the educational objectives of Notre Dame Academy. Email is not guaranteed to be private and can be accessed by school personnel if necessary.
- Academic dishonesty (including plagiarism and cheating) are not tolerated at NDA.
- Music and videos will not be accessed without teacher permission during class.
- Users will not play games or access social media without teacher permission and supervision.
- Cyber Bullying, suggestive, obscene, belligerent, or threatening messages are strictly prohibited.
- Defamatory messages which are based on slurs or stereotypes relating to race, gender, ethnicity, nationality, religion, or sexual orientation are strictly prohibited.
- Do not forward or copy digital communications or content with the permission of the owner.
- Users are to obey all laws, including criminal, copyright, privacy, defamation, and obscenity laws. The school will cooperate with local, state, or federal law enforcement officials with the investigation if a law is broken involving NDA technology.



### CORONAVIRUS UPDATES FOR ACT | SAT | AP EXAMS ◀

**ACT** — ACT has rescheduled its April 4 national test date to June 13 across the US. All students registered for the April 4 test date will receive an email from ACT informing them of the postponement and instructions for free rescheduling to June 13 or a future national test date. Please check the [ACT website](#) for updates. **ALSO:** The March 24 ACT that was scheduled for the juniors has been cancelled. We are working with the Diocese to determine what the makeup date for that test may be in the future.

**SAT** — The SAT for May 2 has been canceled. Makeup exams scheduled for March 28 are also canceled. Registered students will receive refunds.
