STUDENT LIFE UPDATE

Ongoing A.L.I.C.E. Training: Active Threat Drill

In our continuing efforts to ensure safety on our campus, we will have a long homeroom on Monday, April 23 to provide time for an active threat drill as part of our ongoing A.L.I.C.E. training. As you know, A.L.I.C.E. is an acronym for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate. The A.L.I.C.E. program is one component of our school's comprehensive crisis plan and is the protocol NDA has in place in the event of an active shooter situation.

While the likelihood is low that such a tragedy would occur at Notre Dame Academy, our safety and survival in these situations depend on our awareness of the response options available. The A.L.I.C.E. program defines these response options and mentally prepares our school community to respond in ways that will increase chances of survival in violent shooter situations. The active threat drill will enable our NDA community to walk through the process of an active threat and review the strategies and response options needed to handle such a situation.

As part of the active threat drill, students will evacuate the building but will not report to our rally points, they will remain on our campus throughout the drill.

SWAT/Media/Computer Science Students Attend UC Tech EXPO


On Tuesday, April 10, Molly Mullee, Nick Lander and Terri Perrino headed to the UC Tech Expo with some of their students to explore future possibilities.

How has Drug Free Clubs of America played a role in your community, or what more could be done?
- 4. Make sure your essay has your grade, school, and name at the top of the page.
- 5. Turn in the above items by April 20, 2018.

Completed entries turned in by the deadline will be judged internally at NDA and the top 3 will advance to the final round which is judged by the DFCA staff.

The course will be held Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. each day. This ACT Prep Course is aligned with the June 9 and July 14 ACT test dates. The course will be taught by NDA faculty members and features:
