HANDS-ON LEARNING AT NDA

Students in Mrs. Ziegler's Anatomy and Physiology class have recently had some incredible hands-on learning! In an effort to share career pathways with her students, Mrs. Ziegler invites various speakers to her class throughout the school year. Recently, Jeff Arlinghaus, a nurse-anesthetist with St.E's and the NKU's Anesthetist Program, (also father of Jenna Arlinghaus '17 and NDA Bass Fishing Coach) came and taught the students how to administer spinals, epidurals and intubation of the trachea.

NDA alumna Jill Weidner '05, a second year Nurse Anesthesia Resident, came to help Mr. Arlinghaus with the spinal and epidural anesthesia simulation at NDA. Jill is one of 16 students picked for the program out of about 60 applicants.

Exam Schedules

The current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will have exams on May 21, 22 and 23. The students were all emailed their schedules for exams several weeks ago. <u>Click here</u> for a link to the exam schedule. You need



your daughter to share her current class schedule with you in order to see what exams she has at certain times.

Students that do not have an exam last may leave early and those that do not have one first may come in at homeroom. There may be a few students that do not have an exam on a day, and she may not come to school but will need to have a parent call the office to let them know she is out. Please note that most students will be finished by 12:30 p.m. on Monday and 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday. If a student has to miss an exam, there is a fee to re-schedule the exam. Please see the handbook for information about our exam policy.

Senior exams will happen on May 17, 18 and 21. Seniors all have exam schedules and will know if one has to take an exam or may be exempt due to her current grade and attendance. Registration is now open for the 2018 - Summer Sports Camps Hosted at Notre Dame Academy. NDA is hosting several youth sports camps this summer.


