



2016 Notre Dame Academy Distinguished Graduate Emily Walter

Congratulations to NDA senior Emily Walter who received the Distinguished Graduate Award from the Sisters of Notre Dame at this year's Senior Awards Luncheon. The Sisters of Notre Dame Distinguished Graduate Award recognizes graduates in schools sponsored by or affiliated with the Sisters of Notre Dame National Education Partnership, as being outstanding witnesses to Notre Dame education. The names of the award recipients are recorded each year in a book kept in the Motherhouse (international headquarters) of the Sisters in Rome, Italy. It is placed on the altar dedicated to Sr. Maria Aloysia, the founder of the Coesfeld SNDs and an outstanding educator.

FRESHMAN TAKE ACTION AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN HAITI

Children, Inc.'s Service Learning Program is pleased to announce that Notre Dame Academy received the May Jefferson Award for Outstanding Public Service for their service learning project entitled, "Where am I Wearing?" The Jefferson Award Foundation is a prestigious national organization encouraging and honoring community service in America. Founded in 1972 by Robert Taft, Sam Beard and Jacqueline Kennedy Onnasis, they introduced their own public service awards based on the simple premise that each person can make a difference.

This award is offered to acknowledge the contributions made by three freshman students in Ms. Amanda Staggs' class: **Sydney Sparks, Claire James and Fallon McAllister**. The students learned about child slavery in Haiti and decided they needed to take action. The freshman raised \$750 through a Valentine candy sale to support two children with an education and provide supplemental services through the organization, Restavek Freedom. Because of the efforts of these caring Notre Dame Academy students, young children have been saved from the harsh living conditions in Haiti's slave industry and have been given the opportunity for a new life.

These students were chosen by Navigo Scholars Program to participate in a career program with US Bank and the Northern Kentucky Education Council.
