#### iPad UPDATE

The majority of our students are using **Notability** for note-taking. This app allows them to organize their notes by date and subject area. It also allows them to download images, photos, documents and other resources that teachers provide them or that the student finds through her own research and



study. Once these items are added to their notes, students can anno-

tate them with additional information they are learning. **An important reminder for students** is to sync their iPads with a home computer so that they can back up these documents. Users should never rely on document storage in only one place. This is true for laptops and PC's as well.
