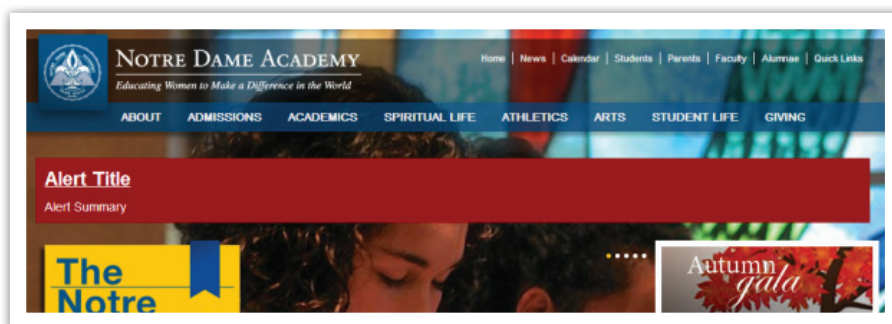
We will also post school closings and delays on our website. You can see an example of how weather related announcements will be displayed on the new website below.

Centre College Fellows Program: Any junior that is interested in Centre College and has an ACT score of a 28 or higher may be eligible for the Centre Fellows Program. This program offers at least a \$14,000 per year scholarship. Murray State University Commonwealth Honors Academy: The Program is offered to juniors who have approximately a 25 or higher on the ACT and a 3.5 G.P.A. It is a 3 week residential program that is completely free. It also gives students who complete the program 6 hours of University credit and an automatic \$2,000 scholarship to Murray State. GAA Parents & Athletes,

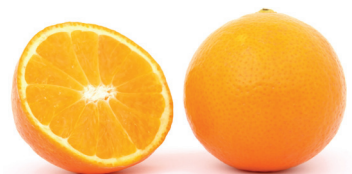
