The Francis X. Weninger and Miguel Pro scholarships are awarded to students attending Xavier University. These 4-year scholarships are awarded to students who are committed to the promotion of diversity in our society and who demonstrate leadership in the classroom, on campus and in the greater community. There are a variety of types of students that contribute diversity-this could mean diversity in terms of ethnicity, religion, being a first-generation college student or another attribute that a student feels could truly add to diversity.

The value of these scholarships ranges up to \$10,000 annually. Priority consideration for these scholarships is given to students with a minimum SAT of 1070 or ACT of 23 and a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.
