Criteria:

- Must be a **resident of Kenton County** and attend a High School in Kenton County

Award:

- One \$500 Scholarship will be awarded to the winning student.

To Apply:

- Submit a 400-600 word essay discussing the importance of a young adult being involved with the Republican Party

Wallace Woods Good Neighbor Scholarship Competition

Deadline: March 31, 2012.

Criteria:

- Must be a **resident of Covington**
- This is a scholarship for young adults who have given back to the community through voluntary service.
- Must be enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4-year post-secondary institution for the 2012-2013 school year (Vocational and Technical programs are included)
- Presented to a student who understands the importance of civic engagement within the young adult community.

Award:

- One \$500 Scholarship will be awarded to the winning student and this scholarship money will be sent to the accredited 2 or 4-year school of the winner's choice.

Deadline: April 6, 2012.

Criteria:

- Must be a 2012 graduating High School senior planning to attend an accredited college or university in the fall of 2012 as a freshman
- Must be a resident of Kenton County **or** attend a Public or Private High School in Kenton County (*If you attend Notre Dame...you are eligible for this scholarship because Notre Dame is in Kenton County. So even if you do not live in Kenton County, you are eligible.*)

Award:

- One (1) \$2,500 Scholarship will be awarded
- Two (2) \$1,000 Scholarships will be awarded

To Apply:

- Send a copy of your high school transcript
- Send at least one letter of recommendation

University of Louisville N.KY/Greater Cincinnati Alumni Association Dane A. Wagge Scholarship

Deadline: May 1, 2012.

Criteria:

- This award is designed to provide financial assistance to outstanding students in N.KY or Greater Cincinnati.
- Must be seeking admission to the University of Louisville and have submitted an application for admission to U of L before April 1.
- Must be a resident of Boone, Kenton, Campbell, Grant, Carroll, Pendleton and Gallatin Counties in Kentucky or of Hamilton County in Ohio.
- Have a Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and an ACT of 20 or above.

Award:

- The recipient(s) will receive a scholarship of \$1000 or more for the school year of 2012-2013.

To Apply:

- Pick up a copy of the application for the *Dane A. Wagge Scholarship Award* from Ms. Burgei.
- Complete the application. (Very Important Note! *There is a back-side to the last page of the application. After the essay section you need to turn the page and there is a place where **applicants must sign and date the application.***)
