CLOSER LOOK AT NOTRE DAME

Work Study Program / Financial Assistance: Notre Dame's Work Study Program makes it possible for families to receive Financial Assistance to subsidize their tuition. Eligible families are assigned jobs to assist in the cleaning of our school. Participation in work-study can reduce a student's tuition significantly. *Currently, 1 out of 6 families participate in the Work Study Program.*

Science Research: Science Research is a ½ credit elective that takes place outside of school hours. Students conduct independent science projects and present at regional, national, and international competitions. Students are required to log 144 hours of work per school year.
