

#### IMPORTANT FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The Business Office is in the process of finalizing grants, aid and work-study jobs for the 2017-18 school year. Once that process is complete, anyone who is receiving financial assistance will get an email from FACTS showing your awards. That email should be coming this week.

FACTS tuition payment information for NEW STUDENTS: The process at NDA may be different from some of the other schools that use FACTS. The Business Office at NDA actually inputs all of your information in FACTS, including academic scholarships earned by incoming freshmen. Once that process is completed you will receive an email from FACTS asking you to join and set up a payment plan. New families cannot set up their FACTS account until they receive that email invitation from FACTS. These invitations should be coming at the end of May.

Current parents will receive notification from FACTS in regard to their payment plans. All plans remain the same year to year unless you notify FACTS that you want to change it. If you wish to change your payment plan (e.g., you now do a monthly plan but want to switch to a one-time payment) you must notify the NDA Business Office or FACTS prior to June 15. Changes to payment plans cannot be made after that deadline. Families wishing to pay tuition in full with a one-time payment, will receive a \$100 discount if they pay in full by July 15. Families who pay in full with a one-time payment are still required to sign up for FACTS since we will be using FACTS for incidental billing again in 2017-2018.

The finance office would like to remind all **Senior parents** that all tuition and fees must be current for your daughter to graduate. Please log into your FACTS account and make sure that you are up to date.

## Notre Dame Urban Education Center In Need of Summer Volunteers


