First of all, let's review for anyone who is not familiar with iTunes U. The iTunes U app gives you access to complete courses from leading universities to Notre Dame Academy. It's the world's largest digital catalog of education content and you can access it from your iPad, mini-iPad, iPhone, or iTouch. Here's the best part - it's FREE!

The NDA iTunes U site was published last school year as part of our 1:1 iPad Initiative. There are now three courses available for subscription on the Notre Dame Academy iTunes U site:



- The NDA SWAT course will benefit all students at NDA and beyond! It contains vital information about all aspects of the iPad and much more.
- The NDA iPad Parent Resource course is for parents who want to learn about the iPad and how their daughters are learning.
- The NDA Faculty course provides pertinent technology information for faculty.

Uniform Policy

Begin preparing for the 2014-2015 school year by taking a look at NDA's uniform policy.

Notre Dame Academy has a school uniform that consists of:

- a gray uniform skirt (the skirt must fit properly, be zipped and buttoned, hemmed appropriately and free of stains, rips, and/or holes). Students are encouraged to purchase a new skirt if it no longer zips, has tears, holes, or stains.
- a white NDA banded shirt for Freshmen through Juniors •
- a navy blue or white NDA banded shirt for Seniors
- solid white, gray, black or navy blue socks
- appropriate shoes that have a back to them

Optional items that may be purchased and worn with the uniform include:

- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy pullover sweater
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy sweatshirt
- a navy blue blazer with NDA's emblem for special occasions such as Mass, award ceremonies, etc. •
- gray, black, or navy blue leggings
- black dress slacks and a white blouse for designated events

No colored undergarments or undergarments with visible writing that detracts from the uniform may be worn under the uniform blouse. If a student chooses to wear a T-shirt under the uniform shirt, it must be a plain white V-neck and may not be visible. No slacks may be worn under the uniform during the school day. Students may wear the uniform sweater or sweatshirt during the school day. No other sweaters or sweatshirts are acceptable.
