- Member's name, school, and grade must be at the top of the essay answer.
- All applications and essays must be postmarked or emailed by midnight 3/24/14.
- All submissions become the property of Drug Free Clubs of America.
- Qualifying essays will be read and voted on by judges with the school and name removed, only the grade will remain. Essays receiving the most votes by judges will win.
- Awards will come in check form, payable to the member, to be cashed and used for education expenses such as tuition, fees, equipment, books, supplies, in accordance to IRS code 117.
