At NDA we are committed to making our tradition of excellence in Catholic education available to any young woman who seeks that opportunity. For this reason, we keep our tuition at an affordable rate, on the average \$3000 per year less than other Catholic schools in our area. Additionally, we provide some form of financial assistance to approximately 30% of our families. The generous support of alumnae, parents and friends of NDA makes this possible.

We have three significant ways in which individuals can provide financial assistance to our school and students. These include our **Annual Raffle**, **Autumn Gala** and **Annual Appeal**.
