TECHNOLOGY UPDATE 🤜

Did you know that there are many different ways to transfer files from your iPad to a computer?



1. There's "Instashare" a fabulous app that allows even more than "AirDrop". AirDrop only allows you to wirelessly transfer documents from OS to OS (Mac computer to Mac computer operating systems) and iOS to iOS (mobile device to mobile device operating systems). Instashare allows you to transfer files from

any iOS device to OS along with everything AirDrop allows. You can share movie files, pictures, pdf files, word files, songs, and even software applications using Instashare. Instashare is free for mobile devices and only \$3.99 for Mac computers. If you desire to limit your sharing to mobile devices, it costs nothing. It's a great tool if you have a file on an iPhone and need to get it to your iPad.



2. Google Drive! Google on your iPad allows you to access all of the documents you have uploaded in your ndapandas.org Google account to be accessable to you anywhere. Which means, you can upload pictures from your iPad into your Google Drive iPad app and access them from anywhere. If your memory on your iPad is low, clean out your iPad's "Photos" and put them in your Google cloud using Google Drive. You can do this with your music, movies, pdf files, songs and more as well.

Stop being a prisoner to one computer and use your iPad resources to set you free!

2014-15 Calendar


NDA's electronic calendar has been updated for the 2014-2015 school year! To access the calendar, go to NDA's website and click "Calendar" in the upper right hand corner.
