Dear Parents,

I am very happy to report that our first week welcoming students back to campus has been very successful. So far we have had orientation days for our seniors, juniors and sophomores and we are excited to have our freshmen back on campus tomorrow. Friday we will have our juniors and seniors attend a regular school day together and Monday will be a full return of our student body.

Please note that our schedule this year will depend heavily on what we have learned in the days, weeks and months prior. Each day this week we have had the opportunity to see what works best for the safe return of our students and we have made adjustments accordingly. I ask that you and your daughter are more attentive than ever to the emails you receive from NDA this school year. With the uncertainly of COVID-19, there are likely to be more changes to our schedule than in past years.

I have another important request of you this evening. I would like you to please encourage your daughter to do her best to make good choices to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 when she is not in school. We are doing everything we can to keep our students safe while they are on our campus but unfortunately safe practices and protocols we follow here at school are not always followed when our students leave school. I know it's difficult for our students to social distance from their friends but if we want to continue to follow an in person plan at NDA this school year, they are going to have to be careful in and out of school. We ask that they simply social distance with members outside of their household, wear a mask outside of their household and wash their hands often and thoroughly. Those simple steps can be the difference between our students attending classes in person or remotely this school year.



NDA COVID-19 SELF TEST ┥

While there have been many new protocols, policies, guidelines and modifications at NDA in order to reopen school for the 2020-21 school year, the NDA COVID-19 Self Test may be one of the best! This self test is completed by NDA students in the morning before they enter the building. Their responses to the Self Test will produce a green or red screen on their phone or iPad. If they receive a green screen, it indicates that they are healthy to attend school that day and they can then show school personnel as they enter the building. If the screen is red, students know that they will need to contact the school nurse before reporting to school. Along with the self test, school personnel will also be taking student temperatures.
