

LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL <

Dear Parents,

I would like to begin tonight by congratulating our Varsity Volleyball team. Our Volleyball Pandas brought home a State Title for the first time in 26 years! We are proud of their hard work and congratulate them. I would also like to thank our JV Volleyball Pandas for their support of our NDA Volleyball Program this season and congratulate them on their District Championship on the road to state!

Tomorrow we transition to Plan 3 of our Pandas Return to School Plan with Remote Learning @ NDA - full remote learning for all students. We will follow this plan for the remainder of this week and you will receive a communication on Friday informing you of how we plan to move forward after this week. In the meantime, students have received an updated schedule for Thursday and Friday and all extracurricular and athletic activities are cancelled for this week.

This transition is being done out of an abundance of caution for some very important reasons:

- This break gives us the time needed to assess our current situation and to complete our contact tracing efforts with the most recent COVID-19 cases.
- With students learning remotely we will have the time to do a deep cleaning of our school building.
- COVID-19 is continuing to spread at an alarming rate in Northern Kentucky with all counties in the red zone.

According to the NKY Health Department, our region is seeing a tremendous increase in daily COVID-19 cases with over 250 new cases daily. The NKY community spread is greatly affecting our NDA community. We truly appreciate the excellent job our faculty, staff and students have done helping to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 at NDA. We attribute their efforts to the fact that we have not had any community spread of COVID-19 at NDA to date. The cases we are currently dealing with and the cases we have had so far this school year are related to activities which took place outside of school.

I have been reminding our NDA community or months how important it is for all of us to make intelligent and unselfish decisions during this challenging time. We must stay focused on the common good and what science tells us about COVID-19: the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.



Masking and social distancing both work - we have proven that at NDA. 
