Dear Parents,

As you read the Panda Press Weekly tonight, it will be obvious to you that we did not anticipate the new restrictions from Governor Beshear this afternoon on gatherings, restaurants and especially schools. Although we had every intention of transitioning back to Plan 1 of our Pandas Return to School Plan with Traditional Learning @ NDA beginning on Saturday, November 21, it looks as though we are going to need to pivot as we have done so many times before in 2020. Rest assured, Dr. Koehl and I will consult with the Diocese and communicate our plan moving forward to you by the end of this week. In the meantime, we continue with Remote Learning @ NDA through Friday as planned.

I do have some good news to share with you today. Our students and faculty members have reported a very smooth transition to Plan 3 of our Pandas Return to School Plan with Remote Learning @ NDA - full remote learning for all students. We invested a great deal of time over the summer developing a more manageble remote learning schedule and it seems to be working. Plan 3 has been well received by our entire community this past week. As much as I love having our students and teachers engaged in education in person at NDA, I can't help but feel blessed to have the technology and plans in place at Notre Dame Academy to undertake remote learning so successfully when necessary.






