FAFSA Information from Kelly Burgei

Seniors and Senior Parents are reminded that the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) can be accessed starting Jan. 1, 2016. It is highly recommended that families complete the FAF-SA by Feb. 1st (I recommend shooting for submitting in the first 2 weeks of January in case you run into any bumps). Here are a few reminders:



- You can start the FAFSA and if you need to stop, you can **'Save'** your work and return to your FAFSA later. It does not need to be completed in one sitting.
- You do not need to have your Income Taxes completed to submit the FAFSA. You can use estimates based on 2014 Tax Information.
- If you have questions throughout the process of submitting your FAFSA, I highly recommend the FAFSA Assistance Center. They are very helpful! :) **FAFSA Assistance:** 1-800-433-3243.
