Green Dot is a nationally recognized bystander strategy focused on preventing violence in all its forms, including bullying, dating violence, and sexual assault. The strategy is based on the belief that each of us holds power as bystanders to actively prevent violence, and to shape our community's norms. Green Dot Specialists trained and practiced with Notre Dame Academy Freshmen and Seniors in November and December about different ways they can intervene in potentially harmful situations, using the "3D's:" Direct intervention, Delegation, or Distraction. NDA Sophomores and Juniors will be trained in January. No one has to do everything, but everyone has to do something.
