-Parents bringing a pasta meal should bring it to NDA by 4:45 p.m. ready to be served (we do not have the capacity to heat the food).

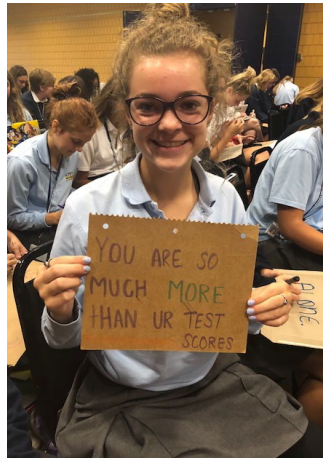
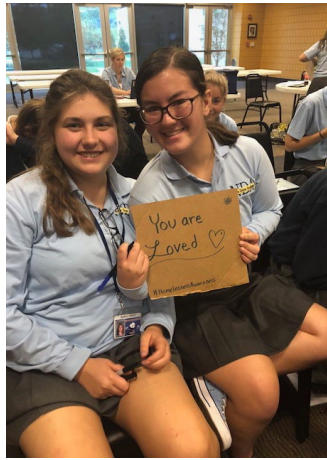
-Parents volunteering to set up, serve and clean should arrive by 4:40 p.m. and we will be finished by 6:15 p.m.

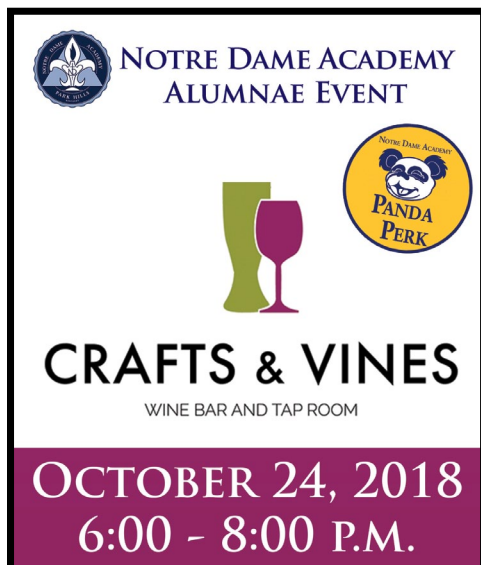
LET THE BIDDING BEGIN! ◀
