I am happy to report that we have had a smooth transition back to Plan 1 of our *Pandas Return to Campus Plan* with a full return to school with safety precautions in place. As the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve with rising positivity rates, we will continue to be flexible and prepared to pivot to one of our other plans should it be necessary. Our students and faculty have done an incredible job this school year and we certainly appreciate their adaptability. Please encourage your daughter to follow COVID-19 mitigation strategies in order that we can continue have in person instruction.

Also, please note the travel advisory information from our school nurse on page 3. As of today, Wednesday, January 6, we have had 11 reported cases of a member of our community testing positive for COVID-19 since we last reported positive cases on December 16. As per our requirements, those involved followed the quarantine guidelines in our <a href="COVID-19">COVID-19</a>
<a href="Response Chart">Response Chart</a>. We also have several members of our NDA community who have had close contact with someone who has tested positive for in quarantine. Please note that 15% of those have chosen remote learning this semester and 41% of those are in quarantine due to travel.

We have consulted with the Diocese of Covington about these recent cases and we thank the families involved for reporting this information and helping to keep our school community safe.

### ADMISSIONS INFORMATION FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

Priority Registration for the 2021-2022 School Year Begins This Week If you have a daughter who is interested in applying as an incoming freshman for the 2021-22 school year, you may do so online with our Application for Admission on the website <u>HERE</u>. The non-refundable registration fee must be paid online with a credit card in order to complete the Application for Admission.

Students who apply for admission during the Priority Application Period have a better chance of receiving seats in high-demand classes such as Art I and some foreign language classes. Students who apply during this period are included in a drawing for a free iPad or a \$500 tuition voucher. Incoming freshmen who are eligible for academic scholarships must apply for admission by the priority deadline in order to confirm receipt of their scholarship.



### SCHOLARSHIP WINNER FOR "I HAVE WINGS FOUNDATION" <


