

LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

I hope your daughter enjoyed having a snow day on Tuesday. As you know, snow days are a very uncommon occurrence at NDA however, with the largest snow total in 13 years, it was definitely necessary. Considering what we've been through these last several months, I'm sure you understand by now my philosophy is that we will make every effort to have students in school. As I sit here this afternoon watching additional snow falling and hearing forecasts of freezing rain, I am praying that this bad weather ends in time for road crews to do their job, allowing our students to safely get to school tomorrow. To be safe, we will have a delayed start tomorrow morning with school beginning at 9 a.m. and we will continue to monitor the weather.

Speaking of off days, **PLEASE NOTE:** we are off school on Monday, February 15 in honor of Presidents Day and we will also be off school on Monday, February 22. Our faculty and staff will be receiving their second COVID-19 vaccination on Sunday, February 21 and we would like to give them the following day off to recover from any possible side effects.

Although we are continuing to see a slight decline in our COVID-19 positive cases, we still need parents and students to be vigilant in reporting COVID-19 issues with us. As I have said in the past, I cannot think of a time when the partnership we have with our parents has been so vital to the education of our students. It is critically important that we continue to work together to keep our students safe and engaged in meaningful learning and I believe that communication is key to our success.

To that end, please keep your daughter home and contact the school nurse if:

- · Your daughter is not feeling well
- · Your daughter or a family member is awaiting COVID-19 test results
- Your daughter or a family member tests positive for COVID-19
- Your daughter has been in CLOSE CONTACT with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19



NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY INDUCTION



Look for the Colonels on Dixie Highway next week when they will be cheering on and commending the Pandas for our good work!




THE SISTERS OF NOTRE DAME – A LEGACY OF INNOVATION AND IMPACT
