

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT & PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

The Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is quickly evolving. This has prompted a great deal of questions and concerns regarding the impact it will have on schools. In addition to taking extra steps to ensure the cleanliness of our environment at NDA, we are also planning and preparing for the possibility of a community-level outbreak in the Greater Cincinnati area.

Should such an outbreak occur, we have developed a contingency plan for what we can do to continue education while minimizing the spread of illness. This plan includes a shift to a virtual school day with remote school learning through the use of iPads, Unified Classroom, Google Meet, and YouTube. Preparations are being made this week for students and faculty to successfully transition to a remote school day should it be necessary. These preparations include a **LATE START to our school day TOMORROW**, **Thursday**, **March 12** in order to give our faculty an opportunity to prepare for the possibility of a virtual school day in the future.

We understand that a remote learning strategy may be difficult for students who do not have internet access at home or who may be required to care for younger siblings. If you find yourself in either of these circumstances or in a situation where it may be difficult for your daughter to participate in a virtual school day, please contact NDA Assistant Principal Mrs. Amber Grayson (graysona@ndapandas.org).

PLEASE NOTE: Students and faculty are encouraged to stay home if ill. Students who are absent will be expected to complete the work as assigned and per the teacher's class policy. As of today, NDA's attendance policy as it relates to credit completion and exam exemption will be uplifted for the time being.

Students are reminded to practice optimal hygiene which includes, but may not be limited to:

- Wash hands thoroughly
- Do not share water bottles, make-up, lipstick/lip gloss, etc.
- Disinfect phones and iPads
- Wear lanyards and use to purchase lunch as to prevent transference of germs
- Practice healthy social distancing

We are also considering prevention efforts and how these may impact athletics, student life and other school events. At this time, no venue has canceled any of our events but we will continue to monitor how these may be impacted.

Please be assured that we are focused on what is best for the health of our students, faculty, staff and community, and for the continuation of learning. While we cannot control the spread of this virus, we can make every effort to mitigate it and we can control how we will continue to meet our responsibility to educate our students.

As always, we appreciate your patience. Thank you for partnering with us in your daughter's Catholic education. We will continue to keep you updated with any additional information as needed.






WKU JUNIOR PREVIEW DAY
