I am happy to report that after two days of Remote Learning @ NDA, our students, faculty and staff all seem to be doing remarkably well and they are engaging in meaningful learning. I cannot fully express my gratitude to you and your daughters for working with us this past week as we blaze the trail of online instruction at Notre Dame Academy. This has truly been a collaborative effort!

Since then, we have concentrated on our theme: *Cultivating Hope and Happiness, Strengthened by God's Love*. We gave each student a Gratitude Journal and asked them to keep track of all of the good things happening in their lives this school year. While the COVID-19 crisis has presented us with some very challenging times, I would ask that we continue to encourage our students to be grateful. No matter how difficult life can feel, there is always something or someone to be grateful for and noting our appreciation can be beneficial in may ways. By being mindful of our gratitude, we can lower our stress, gain perspective and most importantly, strengthen our faith and deepen our relationship with God.




Dear Panda Community!

CORONAVIRUS UPDATES FOR ACT | SAT | AP EXAMS <

ACT — ACT has rescheduled its April 4 national test date to June 13 across the US. All students registered for the April 4 test date will receive an email from ACT informing them of the postponement and instructions for free rescheduling to June 13 or a future national test date. Please check the <u>ACT website</u> for updates. **ALSO:** The March 24 ACT that was scheduled for the juniors has been cancelled. We are working with the Diocese to determine what the makeup date for that test may be in the future.


SAT — The SAT for May 2 has been canceled. Makeup exams scheduled for March 28 are also canceled. Registered students will receive refunds.

AP — No changes regarding the AP exams have been announced. The College Board will have additional information by March 20. Ms. Burgei will keep you updated on the status of AP Exams.
