COVID-19 GOOD CHOICES

Here are some "GOOD CHOICES" that everyone in our NDA community can make to do their part to slow the spread of COVID-19 and make a difference in the world:

- STAY HOME avoid any non-essential travel. Avoid social gatherings. Stay
 home if you are sick, except to get medical care. Most importantly for our students, DO NOT PRACTICE REMOTE LEARNING WITH FRIENDS. Remember, the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.
- PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING by keeping at least 6 feet about two arm lengths away from others if you must go out in public. Avoid close contact with people who are sick. STUDENTS PLEASE stay connected with friends through video and phone calls, texts and social media.
- WASH YOUR HANDS often with soap and water for at least 30 seconds, especially after being in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- AVOID TOUCHING YOUR EYES, NOSE AND MOUTH with unwashed hands.
- CLEAN AND DISINFECT HOUSEHOLD SURFACES daily and high-touch surfaces frequently throughout the day. High-touch surfaces include phones, remote controls, counters, tabletops, doorknobs, bathroom fixtures, toilets, keyboards, tablets and bedside tables. Follow CDC guidance.
- COVER YOUR COUGHS AND SNEEZES. Use a tissue to cover your nose and mouth, and throw used tissues in a lined trash can. If a tissue isn't available, cough or sneeze into your elbow — not your hands. Wash your hands immediately.
- STAY INFORMED ABOUT WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR COMMUNITY and ALWAYS follow the directions of state and local authorities.

FINAL FORMS INFORMATION FOR CURRENT FRESHMAN THRU JUNIOR FAMILIES




What information will I need to register for next year?

If any of the following information has changed, you will need basic medical history and health information. Insurance company and policy number. Doctor, dentist, and medical specialist contact information. Hospital preference and contact information.

Make sure you are on the 2020-2021 school year. You will see screens as shown below.

If your student plans to participate in a sport, then click the checkbox for each. Then, click UPDATE after making your selection. Selections may be changed until the registration deadline on May 1, 2020.

Complete each form and sign your full name in the parent signature field on each page. After signing each, click SUBMIT FORM and move on to the next form.


