

# LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL <

Dear Parents,

Happy Earth Day! I hope you have all had a chance to go outside and enjoy this beautiful day that God has given us!

This has been a tough week for our NDA school community. While we all realize the importance of staying home to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, it's difficult to believe that our school year will end without our students, faculty and staff coming together on our campus. Now that we know that we will continue with Remote Learning @ NDA through the end of our school year, we are better able to give you information regarding our calendar. I would like to reiterate some of the dates and events you learned about yesterday:

#### **Academic School Year Information**

- · Remote Learning @ NDA will continue for the remainder of the 2019-20 school year.
- The 2019-20 school year will end on May 15, 2020.
- Remote Learning from April 20 through May 15 will follow a "D" schedule beginning at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 3:01 p.m. every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Every Wednesday will be a Panda Prime Time (PPT) day. On these days, each of your daughter's teachers will set up a two-hour time period when your daughter can receive additional help.
- Final exams have been cancelled however all required work for classes will need to be completed including project assignments.
- · AP exams will begin on May 11 online.
- Students will have a scheduled opportunity before the end of the school year to retrieve items from their lockers.

Our hearts go out to all of our students at this time, especially our seniors. We are heartbroken for this amazing group of young women and are committed to doing all we can to allow them to experience as many of the wonderful senior traditions at NDA as possible. Please note, there is a special letter to senior parents from Dr. Laura Koehl with information regarding senior activities on the next page.

Parents, I cannot thank you enough for your cooperation and support throughout these last several weeks. We understand how difficult this pandemic has been on not only your daughters but also for your families. Everyone is dealing with their own set of challenges and trying to do what is best for their family during this uncertain time. Dear Senior Parents,

As a follow up to our communication about graduation that was sent yesterday, I wanted to offer the following which I hope will emphasize and clarify our current plans;

- We are working very hard to find creative ways to plan a meaningful and memorable graduation ceremony and associated activities following the guidelines given to us by the Diocese.
- We are handing out caps and gowns this Friday and very much looking forward to seeing our seniors as they drive by for the delivery.
- Mr. VonHandorf and Mrs. Grayson are working with our student leaders on options for the Senior Send Off that typically takes place at the end of the school year. The video that is normally used for that annual event is in production.
- NDA is planning a graduation weekend of celebration for our seniors in July. This has been something we have been
  considering for some time. Our senior class co-presidents, Molly Kleier and Kate Joyce, are surveying their classmates to assist with the planning and timing of these activities.
- Plans for the July celebration would include Senior Awards, a breakfast or luncheon, prom, a possible alternate Senior Send Off - depending on student feedback. While we are required to graduate our students in May, we will find a way to also memorialize that occasion as part of this weekend. Students will be permitted to keep caps and gowns until this July event. This is a work in progress and will depend on the state guidelines for gatherings that are in place at that time.
- There are many traditions associated with our graduation including: red roses, Senior Send Off, valedictorian and salutatorian speeches, senior awards, Baccalaureate, yard signs, the school song, the senior memory book and signing the senior wall. We are working ways to incorporate all of these into our plans for May or July.

Notre Dame Academy is a school sponsored by the Sisters of Notre Dame and a member of the Diocesan system of schools. The diocese provides support to our school in many ways including funds for tuition assistance and providing a framework for collaboration with the other high schools and grade schools on many projects that benefit our teachers and students.

Our goal is to provide for a graduation experience under the current and projected limitations that

- honors and celebrates our graduates,
- provides for the safety of our students, parents, faculty and staff, and
- complies with Diocesan requirements and our SND principles of education.

This is a work in progress. Please watch for additional details in the coming days. On behalf of Mr. VonHandorf and Mrs. Grayson, I appreciate your patience and support as we work though what is undoubtedly one of the most difficult challenges most educators have seen in recent times.


## FINAL FORMS (Current freshmen through junior families only)



# IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SENIORS AND SENIOR PARENTS

No one will need to get out of their car and we request that no one gathers in the parking lot after picking up your cap and gown.
