



PANDAS ATTEND GOVERNORS SCHOOL PROGRAMS ◀

An overwhelming number of NDA students were selected this year to participate in the Kentucky Governor's Schools Programs. A total of fourteen NDA students have been accepted to these select summer programs and seven NDA student were chosen as alternates.
