


LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL <

NDA COVID-19 INFORMATION <

REMEMBER, the <u>NDA COVID-19 Information page</u> on the website has many important resources for parents and students.

IMPORTANT UPDATES <

The Diocesan COVID-19 Committee has reviewed the recent guidance from the Governor's office and the CDC regarding the use of **masks outdoors**. They have updated their guidance with the following changes:

- Masks are no longer required when students or staff are outdoors. This includes recess, PE and other outdoor school activities.
- Student athletes and coaches are no longer required to wear masks at outdoor athletic activities.
- Spectators are no longer required to wear masks at outdoor sporting events.
- For outdoor sports, concession stand workers do not have to wear masks as long as they can distance from other workers.

The <u>Diocese of Covington COVID-19 Return to School Requirements</u> document has been updated with these changes.

ALSO: If a student is absent due to an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, that will be considered an Excused Absence. If a student misses school due to side effects from the vaccine - that will also be considered an Excused Absence. The Excused Absence form will NOT need to be filled out however, students will need to provide medical documentation and/or a copy of their CDC vaccination card to our school nurse, Tina Sizemore, RN. at 859.292.1843 or sizemoret@ndapandas.org or Mrs. McLeod in the front office 859.292.1821 or mcleods@ndapandas.org for the absence to be excused.





HELPING YOUR STUDENT WITH TEST ANXIETY ┥

Exams can cause a lot of stress and anxiety in students. This is not abnormal - particularly since we haven't experienced exams for quite some time at NDA. It is also good to recognize that some stress is good.

As a parent, you can help by encouraging healthy habits now, such as eating breakfast and getting a good night's sleep. Waiting to emphasize these activities until the night before the test can lead to more stress. Another positive way to help is to assist your student in learning how to manage their stress. Thinking they will be entirely stress free if they are doing everything right is unrealistic and so learning to manage the stress by helping your student to relax, or set a study schedule is more valuable. SCHEDULING UPDATES

- The last day to change a College Prep or Honors class for next year is May 14. No student/parent initiated schedule changes will be made in the summer. There is a two week window at the start of the school year to try and make a change if the schedule allows.
- The last day to change an AP class for next year is May 28. This is a hard deadline and we will not be able to drop an AP class in the first 2 weeks of school.
- The schedule is not complete yet and counselors will be trying to resolve conflicts in the next few weeks of school. This may mean that a student will need to choose another course in order for her schedule to work.

MAY IS ASIAN AMERICAN & PACIFIC ISLANDER HERITAGE MONTH <


