

LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

You should have received an email from Notre Dame Academy earlier this afternoon about a situation that took place today at NDA. At approximately 12:45 p.m. we were alerted by local police of a suspicious person in the area. As is our protocol, we immediately put NDA on lock-down securing our building and everyone at NDA from any external threat. Within 10 minutes we received an "all clear" message from local police and they informed us that the suspicious person had been apprehended. We then ended the lock-down and continued with our day at NDA.

Although we are near the end of our school year, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that our priority is always the safety and well being of our students, faculty and staff. Our goal is to provide a safe learning environment where all students can feel secure and be productive in their studies. Please be assured that we are vigilant in ensuring the safety of our campus at all times.

As you will see in the pages below, we have been very busy at Notre Dame Academy in this beautiful month of May. From May Crowning to academic and athletic signings, academic awards, send-off celebrations and the senior/faculty volleyball game, it's been quite a week! I hope you enjoy seeing a bit of the "normal" we have been able to return to this week. It is so good to see the smiling faces of our students when we are at the events being help outdoors.



Our students and parents have many questions about the COVID-19 vaccine, now available for people 12 years old and older.

In line with our mission, we are bringing together a team of NDA alumnae in the medical field to educate our community about the COVID-19 vaccine and answer their questions pertaining to students receiving the vaccine - including how students can receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

IMPORTANT UPDATES

PLEASE NOTE: If a student is absent due to an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, that will be considered an Excused Absence. If a student misses school due to side effects from the vaccine - that will also be considered an Excused Absence. The Excused Absence form will NOT need to be filled out however, students will need to provide medical documentation and/or a copy of their CDC vaccination card to our school nurse, Tina Sizemore, RN. at 859.292.1843 or sizemoret@ndapandas.org or Mrs. McLeod in the front office 859.292.1821 or mcleods@ndapandas.org for the absence to be excused.



2020-21 ACADEMIC AWARDS



NDA STUDENTS CHOSEN FOR ST. ELIZABETH'S M.O.O.N. PROGRAM


