- name tag/lanyard


Optional items that may be purchased and worn with the uniform include:



#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM STUDENT SERVICES

Parents, as we finish out this year, we wanted to let you know of information we have sent out to the students. This information has been communicated to them a few times previously and it has also been in the Panda Press. Here is what I reminded them about the schedule for next year:

- Conflicts have not been generated yet. This means that Ms. Burgei or Ms. Monohan may be contacting students via email in the next couple weeks to let you know that you have a conflict and will need to make a schedule adjustment. Please check it periodically in the next 2-3 weeks. Final schedules will be posted in Powerschool late July.
- The date to switch an Honors or CP class has ended. There is a small window of time (2 weeks) at the start of next year where we may be able to make a change in non AP classes if the schedule allows and it does not bring a class below 12 students.
- The last date to request a move out of an AP class is May 28. We will not be able to move a student out of an AP class next school year
- We will still be able to add classes that are out of the school day such as Chorus, Band, Science Research and Law and Justice now and into the next school year








#### **ALUMNAE STORYBOARD**
