Seniors can wear their college tees with uniform skirts on Monday, May 14.




## SENIOR BREAKFAST TRADITION <



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



# INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

#### Exam Schedules

The current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will have exams on May 21, 22 and 23. The students were all emailed their schedules for exams several weeks ago. <u>Click here</u> for a link to the exam schedule. You need



your daughter to share her current class schedule with you in order to see what exams she has at certain times.

Students that do not have an exam last may leave early and those that do not have one first may come in at homeroom. There may be a few students that do not have an exam on a day, and she may not come to school but will need to have a parent call the office to let them know she is out. Please note that most students will be finished by 12:30 p.m. on Monday and 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday. If a student has to miss an exam, there is a fee to re-schedule the exam. Senior exams will happen on May 17, 18 and 21. Seniors all have exam schedules and will know if one has to take an exam or may be exempt due to her current grade and attendance. **Registration is now open for the 2018 - Summer Sports Camps Hosted at Notre Dame Academy**. NDA is hosting several youth sports camps this summer.


