

Get ready for the next school year and looking to purchase new uniform pieces? Visit Schoolbelles' website at http://www.schoolbelles.com/myschool/ M37/s1935 to purchase. Approved Uniform pieces are listed below as stated in our Student/Parent Handbook:

- a gray uniform skirt or uniform slacks (the skirt or pants must fit properly, be zipped and buttoned, hemmed appropriately and free of stains, rips, and/or holes). Students are required to obtain a new skirt or pants if it no longer zips, has tears, holes, or stains.
- a white or light blue banded Notre Dame Academy polo shirt
- solid white, gray, black or navy blue socks
- appropriate shoes that have a back to them
- name tag/lanyard

Optional items that may be purchased and worn with the uniform include:

- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy pullover sweater
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy cardigan sweater
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy sweatshirt (available for purchase through Schoolbelles and NDA's Bambootique*)
- a navy blue Notre Dame Academy fleece
- a navy blue blazer with NDA's emblem for special occasions such as Mass, award ceremonies, etc.
- gray, black, or navy blue leggings
- black dress slacks for designated events

ART CAMPS:

Junior High Studio Art class is still going to happen this summer, same dates, same time, but the NEW limit on the class will be 15 students total.

The High School Summer Studio Art Class is still going to happen, the dates are the same and the times are the same, but we're incorporating some measures to ensure the safety of the students. We will be splitting the class into 2 sections, (Section A and Section B) and will be rotating the days when each section meets to limit the amount of students who are physically present in the studio. While one section is working in studio, the other section will be working from home giving each section 10 days in the studio, and 10 days working remotely. If any student or family is uncomfortable with being in the studio, we will also provide an option to complete the course entirely from home by offering live instruction, pre-recorded demos, and Google Meets during class where any student will have the opportunity for instruction.


SAVE THE DATE!
