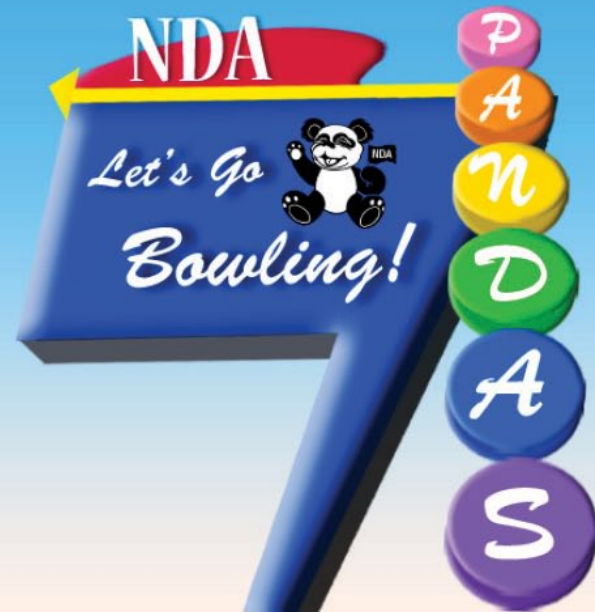

“What’s Going on for Girls and How We Can Help Them” ◀

Notre Dame Academy is pleased to announce that on August 12 at 6:30 p.m., we will sponsor a very special presentation for parents. Dr. Lisa Hinkelman founder and Executive Director of the ROX foundation will present “What’s Going on for Girls and How We Can Help Them” – a presentation about the many issues girls and young women face in our modern world. Dr. Hinkelman has done extensive research and written books and articles about girls’ issues. She is the author of “Girls Without Limits: Helping Girls Achieve Healthy Relationships, Academic Success and Interpersonal Strength”. Dr. Hinkelman will share her expertise on ways to make girls successful in their school and personal lives. Dr. Hinkelman is including this presentation as part of her visit to our Diocese that week to speak to our diocesan teachers.

The Diocese has invited Dr. Lisa Hinkelman to present an anti-bullying program to our diocesan teachers on August 13. The NDA faculty will attend this presentation on that day. This professional development opportunity will focus on bullying in schools and ways that educators can work to prevent it. There has been a growing awareness of this issue across our nation and our Catholic schools are not immune to incidents of bullying. This educational opportunity for our teachers is just one component of the anti-bullying efforts in place at NDA as well as other schools in our diocese.
