



The Greater Cincinnati Collegiate Connection (GC3) has collaborated to develop an online resource for the college application process this year. It includes contact information, what type of visits one can expect and arrange, testing requirements and application deadlines for any GC3 member college or university engaging with high school students. Cost is only \$25/year...(because Notre Dame Academy pays the cost of \$10 for every student member!) but, if you join as a Freshman and pay \$75 for 3 years, your 4th/Senior year is FREE!!

The Kentucky Governor's Scholars Program (GSP) is a free 5-week residential program for outstanding KY students the summer after completing their 11th grade of high school. The program provides academic and personal growth through a strong liberal arts program balanced with a full residential life experience while living on a KY college campus. Students complete an application and compete with others from across the state. GSP hopes to have current information and videos posted on their website by September 4th that explain the 7 sections of their application. Blau Mechanical

The origin of Blau Mechanical, Inc. dates back to 1941 when Nick Blau began Nick Blau Heating on Scott Street, Covington, KY. In 1966

Nick Blau incorporated the firm in Kentucky and changed its name to Nick Blau Heating, Inc. In 1974 the firm was sold to Vicente Salazar. In 1978 the firm's name was changed to Blau Heating, Inc. In 1987, once again, the corporate name changed to its present form to better represent the changing and expanding scope of activities in which Blau Mechanical, Inc. has become involved. In October, 1996 Blau Mechanical moved to our new facility located at 1532 Russell Street.
