

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Greetings parents!

I hope you and your family enjoyed a relaxing Thanksgiving. As we begin this Advent Season, we find special ways to pause and reflect on our spiritual journey and the many blessings of our NDA sisterhood. Each morning one of the girls reads an Advent Prayer over the PA. I have shared one of those prayers with you below. During Advent week we are also celebrating Reconciliation in all Religion classes.

This week I have some important staff updates to share with you. First of all, Athletic Director Myanna Webster will be on maternity leave from December 11, 2014 through January 23, 2015. During her absence Ms. Nancy Winstel will serve as the Interim Athletic Director. Ms. Winstel is a well-known professional in Northern Kentucky athletics. She has served our region for over 30 years, including her long and successful tenure as the head coach of the NKU women's basketball team.

As you may know, Ms. Maggie Perrino was recently appointed the new Theater Director at the Carnegie in Covington. We are sorry to see Ms. Perrino leave NDA, but congratulate her on this new opportunity. We have hired Ms. Caroline Stine to serve as the Theater Director for the remainder of the year. Ms. Stine is an adjunct theater instructor at NKU and has been involved in directing young people in community theater programs for the last seven years.

Regarding the Principal position, some of you may have seen the recent ad in The Messenger. When I was appointed President last year, there was limited time to find a new Principal and this process was postponed to the current year. Since 2006, NDA has embraced the President/Principal model as the most effective form of leadership for our school. I look forward to hiring a Principal to join me in the leading NDA beginning in the 2015-16 school year. We will provide updates on the process as it progresses.

The end of the quarter is approaching quickly. Exams will be held on December 17-19. The exam schedule will be posted on the website by the end of this week. Students are required to wear their uniforms for exams. The second quarter will end on the last day of exams. The third quarter will begin when we return from Christmas break on January 5. Students should have all work for the 2nd quarter completed prior to our Christmas vacation.

PANDAS CAN THE COLONELS

We invite all past, present and future Pandas to join us in praying the rosary for Grace White. Grace is the daughter of NDA alum Amy Cobble White '94 and Covington Catholic alum Scott White '93. Grace was recently diagnosed with DIPG, a very rare form of brain cancer and she is currently undergoing radiation and chemotherapy.

As a school dedicated to Our Lady, the community of Notre Dame Academy believes in the power of praying the rosary. Each morning before school begins, former NDA art teacher, Sr. Mary Reina makes her way to the chapel at NDA to lead students, faculty and staff in a decade of the rosary. During the month of December, we will pray each day with the intention of Grace White and her family.

We ask all Notre Dame Academy students, faculty, staff, parents, alumnae and friends to join us in praying the rosary for Grace White and her family during this

most difficult time in their lives. In an effort to support the White family, rosaries will be sold in NDA's Bambootique and through the Alumnae Department for \$5 each with all proceeds going to Operation Grace White.

As Catholics, we do not merely believe, we know, that the rosary is the most powerful recitation we can make when we desire a miracle or some other grace from God. Sister Lucia of Fatima told us that "There is no problem, I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot solve by the prayer of the Holy Rosary. With the Holy Rosary we will save ourselves. We will sanctify ourselves. We will console Our Lord and obtain the salvation of many souls."


