Grandparents Mass **Oct. 19** - All students may invite their grandparents to attend Mass in the gym from **1:30 - 3:03pm**. Parking will be available in the school lot.

Silver Bells **Dec. 14** - This is a semi-formal dance for Sophomores through Seniors and held at NDA. Appropriate attire is required. This is a drug and alcohol free event, and random breathalyzing will occur. Students are required to attend school all day on the day of the event.

Mother/Daughter Dance **Jan. 12** - This event is sponsored by the PPC and is held in the evening at Receptions in Erlanger from **7:00 to 11:00pm**. It includes food, fun, and dancing. Tickets will be sold in advance. Photos are available for purchase through Lifetouch. According to Diocesan Policy, alcohol may not be served or consumed at this event.

Exams **Jan. 15 - 17**- Students will follow a special half-day schedule each of these days in order to have an exam in each of their classes. In some classes, exemption may be offered.

Father/Daughter Dance **Jan. 25**- This event is sponsored by the PTO and is held at Receptions in Erlanger from **7:00 - 11:00pm**. It includes food, fun, and dancing. Tickets will be sold in advance. Photos are available for purchase through Lifetouch. According to Diocesan Policy, alcohol may not be served or consumed at this event.

Prom **March 22** - Junior/Senior Prom is a formal dance held at Cincinnati Music Hall. Dinner is provided, and appropriate attire is required. The PPC plans and provides an After Prom Event at Notre Dame Academy for the students. Prom is school sponsored and drug and alcohol free. Random breathalyzers will be administered.

Final Exams **May 20,21,22**- Seniors will follow a special half-day schedule each of these days in Order to have an exam in each of their classes, **Unless otherwise exempt**.

GRADUATION EVENTS

Graduate Services **Oct. 26** - Graduate Services will be at NDA during long homeroom to speak to Seniors and to give them information about graduation announcements, etc. They will return on **November 8** during lunch to take orders.

Graduation Tickets & Caps/Gowns **April/May** - Seniors will receive tickets for graduation. Students will receive caps and gowns as long as there are no outstanding bills or detentions, and the student is passing all of her classes.

Baccalaureate Mass **May 23 - 7:00-8:30pm.** at St. Agnes. The Mass is the final class Mass for the Seniors before they graduate. Seniors are invited along with their families to attend this celebration. All Seniors are invited to assist in planning this celebration sometime in the beginning of May. Seniors also have the opportunity to sign up to minister during the Mass as lectors, Eucharistic ministers, greeters, and other various ministries. Seniors who have expressed an interest in participating in these ministries are chosen at random. Seniors wear their gowns to the mass and sit together as a class. No cap is worn this evening.

IMPORTANT: Seniors must wear a white or light colored dress or skirt and top under the gown. The skirt or dress may not be longer than the gown.

Senior Breakfast **May 24 - 8:30-11:00am** Senior Breakfast for seniors and their parents at Receptions in Erlanger. Seniors dress up for this event.

Graduation **May 24 - 4:00pm.** The graduation ceremony lasts about one hour and 15 minutes and will be held at the Northern Kentucky Convention Center. "You See Photography" will be at the ceremony. They will take a portrait of each Senior before the ceremony as well as a picture of each girl as she receives her diploma. They also take candid, group shots, etc. Proofs will be mailed to each student, and purchase is optional.
