Dear Parents of the Classes of 2027, 2028, and 2029,

Thank you for choosing Notre Dame Academy for your daughter. Your commitment to the value of an all-girls Catholic education is very much appreciated. We are grateful to have the opportunity to serve your family in this important ministry sponsored by the Sisters of Notre Dame. We understand that paying for a Catholic education can be a significant sacrifice, and therefore, we are diligent in our efforts to ensure that a Notre Dame Academy education is a worthwhile investment and affordable to each of our families.

Below is tuition information for the 2026-27 school year. Notre Dame Academy continues to strive for excellence in our financial stewardship and remains sensitive to the financial challenges of our families.

NDA Tuition Rates for the 2026-2027 School Year

Per diocesan regulations, there are two rates of tuition: the Diocesan rate for Catholic students registered in a parish in the Diocese of Covington; and the Non-Diocesan rate for students who are not Catholic or who are Catholics but are not registered in a parish in the Diocese of Covington.

Diocesan Rate

For Catholic students registered in a parish within the Diocese of Covington

Non-Diocesan Rate

For students who are not Catholic or Catholic students not registered in the Diocese of Covington

First Daughter

Tuition: \$12,593

Second Daughter

Tuition: \$11,448

Third Daughter

Tuition: \$7,087

Annual Fee: \$590

Tech Fee: \$650

SRO Fee: \$140 per family

NDA/CCH Sibling Tuition Discount - A sibling tuition policy provides a \$500 tuition discount at both Notre Dame Academy and Covington Catholic High School when siblings are attending these schools at the same time. If a third son or daughter is involved, both schools will provide a \$1,500 discount.

New this year - All families with sophomores, juniors, and seniors are required to complete a tuition contract through FACTS and pay a \$200 non-refundable tuition deposit. This deposit will be deducted from tuition for the 2026-27 school year. This enrollment contract and tuition deposit are due by June 5, 2026.

The FACTS Management Company helps us manage our tuition payment program. If you are a current NDA parent already using FACTS, your account information will remain the same, however, you will need to electronically sign the tuition contract, pay the non-refundable tuition deposit, and select a payment plan. Returning families will receive an invitation from FACTS to complete their tuition contract and pay their tuition deposit. If you are having difficulty accessing the system or do not receive an invitation or notification by May 15, 2026 please contact FACTS customer support at 866-441-4637.

New parents who are not currently enrolled in FACTS will receive an email invitation from FACTS Management to enroll in a tuition payment plan in May. You cannot sign up until you receive an emailed invitation from FACTS. The invitation will contain your Unique Code for setup in the system and will contain detailed information about access to the FACTS system from our website. You will assign your own unique username and password and indicate your preferred tuition payment plan. You will be able to view your financial aid award package once it has been finalized and uploaded in FACTS.

New NDA families who currently have FACTS accounts through a grade school can keep their existing username and password and use the Unique Code to add NDA to their existing FACTS account.

Families who pay tuition in full by June 30, 2026, will receive a credit of \$250. You need to set up a FACTS account even if you pay in a lump sum. We use FACTS to manage our incidental billings so you will need an account regardless of your tuition payment choice. Incidental fees include athletic fees, theatre fees, and some occasional fees such as field trips and other incidental expenses.

We are committed to providing an affordable education to all our families which means working to meet the needs of each family based on their individual circumstances. Through the generous support of our benefactors, we have a tuition assistance fund for those with demonstrated financial need. We strongly encourage families who want their daughters to have the advantage of an NDA education, but are concerned about affordability, to apply for financial aid. This may include a grant, scholarship, a work-study job, or a combination of financial assistance methods. Every family who receives financial assistance from NDA is expected to have a Work-Study Job. Although the deadline has passed, families may still apply by going to ndapandas.org/admissions/financial-assistance.
