On Friday, Bishop Iffert joined us for the celebration of the Eucharist. It was a great way to begin 2023 as a school community. Bishop Iffert spoke to our students about John the Baptist and his vocation as the forerunner of the Messiah. He went on to encourage our students to each discover her own vocation and her purpose in life. His homily went hand-in-hand with our theme for this school year: *Discovering our purpose. Transforming the world*. His words emphasized what we do at Notre Dame Academy each and every day - educate young women to use their God-given gifts to make a difference in the world. Bishop Iffert also talked to our students about the virtue of humility which can be a difficult thing to talk about in today's world. His words were very relevant for our students and I would encourage you to have a discussion with your daughter about Bishop Iffert's homily. Here is a short excerpt:

"The humble person is not one who is walked on, but rather the person who can maintain their higher faculties in the face of unrighteousness. A humble person doesn't lose control, is not quick to anger and does not become irrational in the face of opposition and challenge. The meek person know themselves, knows their abilities, knows their strengths, knows the use of reason and in the face of challenge and in even injustice, the meek person maintains their ability to respond with calmness and reason. Humility doesn't make us a doormat, it let's us remain courageous. Meekness is a sub virtue of courage that allows us to face the world with an unflappable confidence."

Thank you for partnering with us in your daughter's Catholic education. It is a privilege for us to have the opportunity

to educate the young women of NDA in the tradition of the Sisters of Notre Dame and to work with you to instill in them the spiritual and moral values that will prepare them for a life of success, community service and personal fulfillment.

BUSY PANDAS! AQUA PANDA UPDATE

The AquaPandas have competed in several swim meets over the past few weeks:

Girls Night Out...

On Friday, December 16, the AquaPandas finished 5th (out of 11 schools) in the Girls Night Out meet hosted by Trintity HS at Ralph Wright Natatorium (University of Louisville). There were right around 20 heat winners who were awarded a pink rose. Lainy Kruger broke Ellen Williamson's (NDA alum) 2009 meet record in the 100 IM with a time of 57.41.

SHDHS Winter Classic...

On Saturday, December 17, less than 24 hours after competing in the GNO meet, the AquaPandas swam in the St. Henry DHS Winter Classic at Keating Natatorium (St. Xavier HS), finishing a close second to Assumption HS from Louisville and besting 13 other schools.

St. Ursula Dual Meet...

On Wednesday, December 28, the team competed well, but ultimately lost a dual meet vs. Ohio powerhouse St. Ursula HS at Keating Natatorium (St. Xavier HS). The AquaPandas won 4 of the 8 individual events and 1 of the 3 relays, but were unable to match the Bulldogs' depth.

Lafayette and Dunbar Tri-Meet...

On Thursday, January 5, the team traveled to Asbury University (just outside of Lexington, KY) to compete against Lafayette HS and Paul Dunbar HS. The AquaPandas split the two meets, besting Lafayette, but falling to a strong Paul Dunbar squad.

Freshman Priority Application Period Any student interested in applying as an incoming freshman for the 2023-24 school year at Notre Dame Academy may apply online with the <u>Application for Admission</u>. The non-refundable registration fee must be paid online with a credit card in order to complete the Application for Admission.

Students who apply for admission during the Priority Application Period have a better chance of receiving seats in high-demand classes such as Art I and some foreign language classes. Students who apply during this period are included in a drawing for a free iPad or a \$500 tuition voucher. Incoming freshmen who are eligible for academic scholarships must apply for admission by the priority deadline (February 10) in order to confirm receipt of their scholarship.
