



JANUARY 9 - FEBRUARY 10, 2023 FRESHMAN PRIORITY REGISTRATION

Any student interested in applying as an incoming freshman for the 2023-24 school year at Notre Dame Academy may apply online with the <u>Application for Admission</u>. The non-refundable registration fee must be paid online with a credit card in order to complete the Application for Admission.

Students who apply for admission during the Priority Application Period have a better chance of receiving seats in high-demand classes such as Art I and some foreign language classes. Students who apply during this period are included in a drawing for a \$500 tuition voucher. Incoming freshmen who are eligible for academic scholarships must apply for admission by the priority deadline (February 10) in order to confirm receipt of their scholarship.
