

### Dear Parents,

Last week our Admissions Department hosted its spring Panda Preview Night for 6th and 7th graders interested in getting a head start on making their high school decision. I am happy to report that we had more families in attendance than we have ever had in the past which leads me to draw a couple of important conclusions. First of all, I think students are making their high school decision earlier than they have in the past. Secondly, I believe that more families are recognizing the value of a Catholic education at Notre Dame Academy.

When we host admissions events, we talk about the Catholic school difference. As a parent of a student at Notre Dame Academy, you are well informed of NDA's strong academic tradition of empowering young women to make a difference in the world. You are also aware of how Notre Dame Academy helps develop each student in an environment that fosters growth of the whole person, striving to instill in young women not only knowledge, but also spiritual and moral values. You understand how blessed we are at NDA to be able to offer a single-gender education grounded in the SND tradition and charism. By the time your daughter graduates, you can be sure that their Notre Dame Academy education has prepared them for a life of success, community service and personal fulfillment.

What we don't talk about enough is what happens after our students leave NDA. We hear back from our alumnae that they are well prepared for post-secondary education and for life and recently we have reviewed data that proves that point. What we have found is that there are some very good indicators of return on investment of a Notre Dame Academy education. You can begin by taking a look at our most recent graduates, the Class of 2021:

- · 100% of Students Graduated from NDA
- 99% Enrolled in Post Secondary Education (97% of Students Enrolled in a 4 Year College)
- · 96% of Graduates Were Offered a College Scholarship with 42% receiving half tuition or more


While those numbers are very impressive, what is more outstanding are the statistics regarding Notre Dame Academy alumnae college graduation rates. Over the last 5 years, an average of 82% of NDA alumnae graduated from college in 4 years. This is remarkable when you compare that to only 52% of students at public universities in Kentucky who graduated in 6 years. As parents I'm sure that you appreciate not only your daughter's preparedness for what follows high school but also the cost effectiveness of her graduating from college in four years. I hope these statistics give you assurance that that a Catholic education at Notre Dame Academy is a wise investment in your daughter's future.

### PREVENTATIVE HEART SCREENING THIS WEEKEND & COVID-19 UDPATES

Dear Parents,

MCORE Foundation will be back at Notre Dame Academy this Saturday, April 2, 2022, to provide our preventative heart screening program. We have worked with MCORE to provide a screening program to our community since 2019. This is an amazing opportunity for a student to have their heart evaluated for any abnormalities in a cost-offsetive and convenient manner aspecially if they have had Covid 10. We appearance



effective and convenient manner, especially if they have had Covid-19. We encourage anyone interested to <u>watch their video</u> to learn more about MCORE Foundation.

The CDC has expanded eligibility for an additional booster dose for certain individuals who may be at higher risk of severe outcomes from COVID-19. Boosters are safe, and people over the age of 50 can now get an additional booster 4 months after their prior dose to increase their protection further. This is especially important for those 65 and older and those 50 and older with underlying medical conditions that increase their risk for severe disease from COVID-19 as they are the most likely to benefit from receiving an additional booster dose at this time. CDC, in collaboration with FDA and our public health partners, will continue to evaluate the need for additional booster doses for all Americans.

CDC's new COVID-19 Quarantine and Isolation calculator takes the stress out of deciding when, and for how long, people with COVID-19 and close contacts need to stay home, get tested, and wear a well-fitting mask. The calculator provides important information about what precautions people with COVID-19 and their close contacts can take to protect loved ones and prevent COVID-19 in their communities. This online, mobile-friendly calculator provides a simple, easy-to-use way to help people follow CDC's Quarantine and Isolation guidance and get customized information that applies to their unique situation. As the weather moves between winter and spring, Pandas are reminded of the dress code expectations listed below. Please note: skirts should extend below one's fingertips when arms are fully extended at their sides. Sweatpants are not an acceptable layer under uniform skirts. ### Notre Dame Academy has a school uniform that consists of:

- a gray uniform skirt or uniform slacks (the skirt or pants must fit properly, be zipped and buttoned, hemmed appropriately and free of stains, rips, and/or holes). Students are required to obtain a new skirt or pants if it no longer zips, has tears, holes, or stains.
- · a white or light blue banded Notre Dame Academy polo shirt
- solid white, gray, black or navy blue socks
- appropriate shoes that have a back to them
- nametag/lanyard

Next Monday, April 4, the freshman students will be taking the Terrace Metrics, Inc. Assessment during homeroom time to examine the social/emotional strengths and needs of the students. While not a diagnostic tool, this survey will allow us to gauge their needs and provide valuable support and interventions as needed. We also administered this assessment in the fall and a second administration will allow us to see any changes as well as gauge their current social/emotional status.

As a parent you will receive a results report of your daughter's survey the week of April 4. For this survey we will only be looking at the following resilience indicators: global satisfaction, grit, hope, leadership, personal standards, positive school experience, and resiliency. The data gathered via Terrace Metrics is kept strictly confidential and only those on the counseling team and administration will have access to the data from the school. 
